We welcome diverse formats of engagement, fostering dialogues and creative responses to the climate crisis across the arts and humanities.

- Reviews of exhibitions or books (up to 1000 words)
- Write-ups of creative practice (up to 2000 words)
- Position papers (up to 3000 words)
- Knowledge & cultural exchange projects (up to 2000 words)
- Interviews (up to 2000 words)
- Visualisations of climate (1 page)
- Exploring themes of climate in the Arts and Humanities curriculum.
- Localised, community and place-based approaches to climate action in and through visual culture
- Art and design innovations in tackling climate challenges
- Migratory aesthetics and the <u>Panicocene</u>
- · Climate anxiety and creative approaches to health and wellbeing
- New forms of learning in climate breakdown or climate hope through the environmental humanities
- Ecological or regenerative practices that challenge dominant social, political, and economic conventions
- Arts and Culture's contribution to Sustainable Development Goals
- Experiences of land trauma and <u>Solastalgia</u> from the perspective of land dependent communities.


